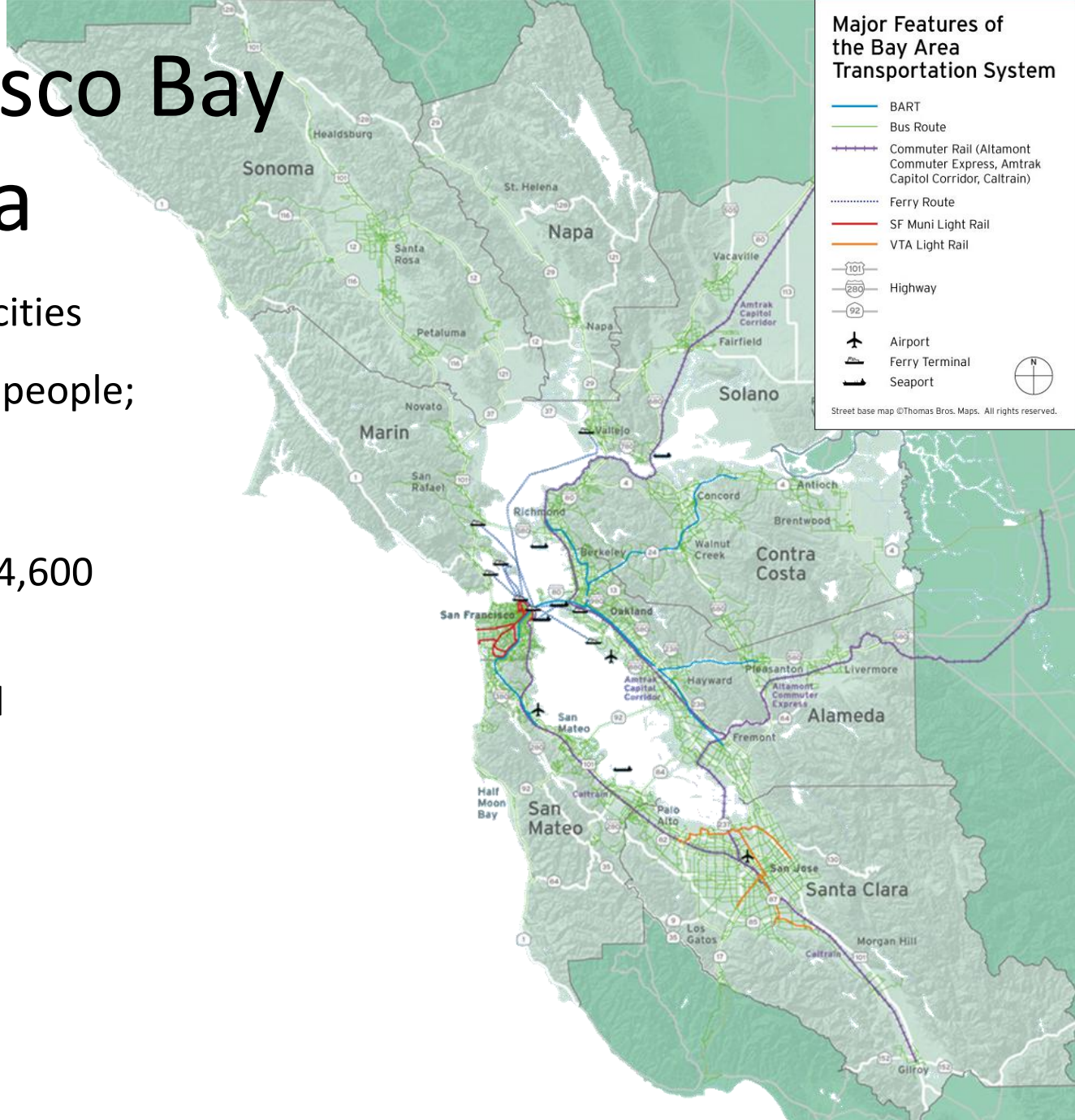

San Francisco Bay Area

- 9 Counties and 100 cities
- More than 7 million people; almost 4 million jobs
- 4.5 million cars and 4,600 transit vehicles
- 19,600 miles of local streets, 620 miles of freeways and 8 toll bridges
- 2 major ports and 3 major airports



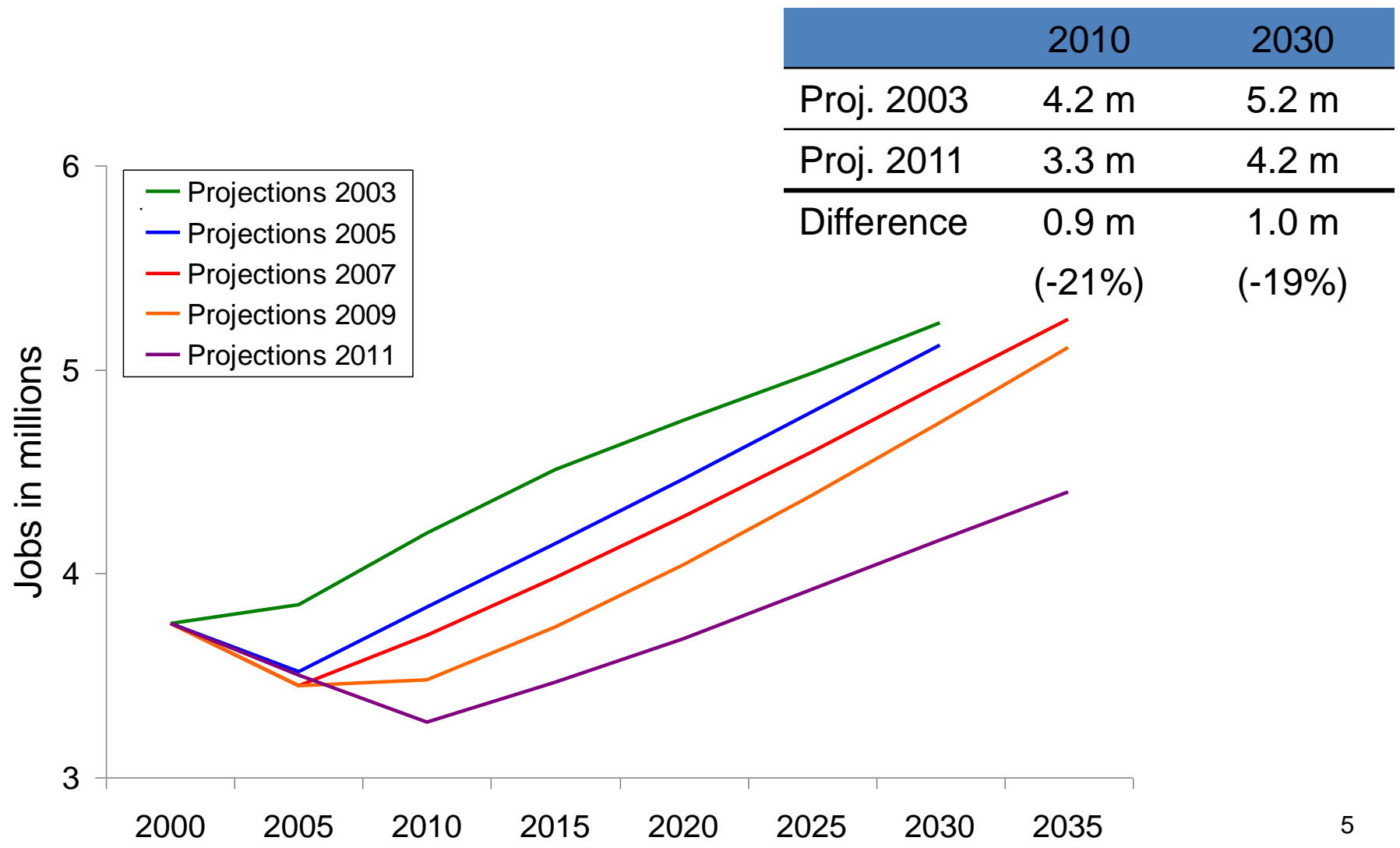
Express Lane Network

In Transportation 2035 Plan

- 800 directional miles
- 500 miles of converted HOV
- 300 miles of new lanes
 - 60% are “gap closures”
 - 5% increase in freeway lane-miles



Revised Economic Outlook



Backbone Concept

- 520 directional miles
- 330 miles of converted HOV
includes existing I-680 southbound Express Lane
- 190 miles of new lanes

Note: new dual lanes are proposed for 120 directional miles
