1957

Introduction of toll booths and acceptance of cash

1999

Addition of both Electronic Toll Collection and cash.

Dedicated ETC lanes for SunPass

2003



Dedicated Open Road Tolling Lanes

2007



Single dedicated express lanes(I-95) to provide mobility for customers

2011

- Flat credit card fee that is trued up at the end of each month.
- Flat transaction fee of 13 cents(adjusted up for CPI if needed)


