- Another part of future office systems is information storage and retrieval...The replacement for the filing cabinet could be magnetic or optical disks, and "don't rule out microfilm yet"
- Xerox expects to keep its momentum going with a new plain-paper Telecopier that combines a laser and xerography to send documents over ordinary phone lines at the rate of two minutes per page.
