### **Program Overview**

- > Goal: Move More People, Not More Vehicles
- > \$290 M Program Budget (\$210 M UPA/CRD Grant) HOV to HOT Conversion
- > 1<sup>st</sup> Express Lanes in LA
- > 110 Launched: 11/10/12 10 Launched: 2/23/13





### **Policy Issues**

- State Tolling Authority Required No Change in Minimum Occupancy
- > Differing Occupancy per Corridor I-110: HOV@+ Toll-Free I-10: HOV@+ Toll-Free at all times but HOV@ Toll-Free only during off-peak period





### **Tolling Policy**





- Optimize Vehicle Throughput at Free-Flow Speeds Through Dynamic Pricing – minimum threshold is 45 mph
- > Minimum Toll per Mile: \$0.25; Maximum Toll per Mile: \$1.40
- > Toll-free travel for vehicles that meet the minimum occupancy requirement (including buses (public & private) & motorcycles)
- Minimum Toll during the Peak Period must be 150% higher than Express Bus fare
- > Tolling Changes to "HOV Only" if avg speeds fall below 45 mph for more than 10 minutes





## Dynamic Pricing Algorithm

- > Updates Every 5 Minutes
- > Toll Rates will vary within the \$0.25 \$1.40 per mile range based on traffic levels in the ExpressLanes to ensure average speeds of 45 mph
- > If a SigAlert occurs, the customer account will automatically be credited.


