CENTER OF MANUAL VALIDATION

The Center of Manual Validation is designed for the live stream and evaluation of incidents, which are connected with the toll gates. This center is open 24/7/365. Attendees will see how every single passing (there are approx. 80,000 instances monitored/day) through the toll gate is validated.

TOLL SYSTEM SHOWROOM

Attendees will learn about the technologies that are used for the toll service and other systems including toll gates, the DSRC system, incident management and license plate recognition.

TRAFFIC SYSTEM DEPARTMENT

Attendees will be introduced to the technical support of the toll system. If the system detects a bug, it is sent to this center where the repairs are managed. This center operates 24/7/365 and is the monitoring center for the tolling systems throughout the Czech Republic.
