




The Toll Roads

51 miles open

- First segment opened in 1993
- Comprises 20% of the freeway network in Orange County
- \$220 Million Plus in Annual Toll Revenue

Unique

- Two Joint Powers Authorities
 - 18 Board Members appointed by city councils and 3 County Supervisors
- Partnership with the State DOT
 - TCA responsible for planning, engineering, financing, construction, toll collection
 - Caltrans owns the roads, responsible for maintenance and patrolling
- Tolls is the primary source of revenue and the agencies are highly leveraged

Firsts

- TCA opened the first toll road in California in 1993. By 1999 51 miles of the system were open.
- TCA developed the FasTrak® brand for electronic toll collection – the FasTrak brand is used throughout the State of California.



 TCA's federal line of credit evolved into the federal TIFIA program bringing low-cost federal loans to infrastructure projects all over the country.

- TCA stopped collecting cash on May 14
 - FASTRAK* Transponder tolling
 - EXPRESSACCOUNT™ license plate tolling
 - ONE-TIME-TOU™ online payment for infrequent drivers
- 5 years of planning and implementation
- Implemented to reduce equipment and maintenance costs and improve efficiency

I-15 Express Lanes

- 20-mile facility with reversible lanes.
- Avg daily traffic: 57K (SOV: 13K; HOV: 44K)
- Tolls: \$.50 \$8
 Avg toll: \$2.07

Avg trip: 10 miles



I-15 Rapid Transit Service

- Tolls help fund public transit.
- New level of transit service – Rapid launched in June.
- Rapid takes advantage of Express Lanes to deliver faster, more reliable travel times.



South Bay Expressway

- 10-mile toll road serving one of the fastest growing areas in the SD region.
- Acquired by SANDAG in December 2011 for about 33 cents on the dollar.




Toll Road Usage Up by >55% Since SANDAG Acquisition

- Avg daily traffic: 36K
 (Avg weekday around 41K)
- FasTrak tolls:\$.50 \$2.75 (Avg \$1.69)
- Cash/credit tolls:\$2 \$3.50 (Avg \$2.78)



SR 11/Otay Mesa East Port of Entry

- Border wait times routinely exceed 2 hours for cars and 4 hours for trucks.
- Border delays cost the CA/Baja CA economies
 \$7.2B each year equivalent to 18 Super Bowls.



SR 11/Otay Mesa East Port of Entry

- Phase I of SR 11 began construction in Dec. 2013.
- Total project cost: \$700M-\$750M.


