There will be visits to several microbreweries as well as a tap room, along with beer samples at each stop and a pint of your choice at the end of the tour. If you are interested in learning more about the history of beer, how it is made, what the different types are and how they differ, and why Denver has been dubbed the "Napa Valley of Beer," then the Denver Microbrew Tour is for you!

Denver B-Cycle – Denver B-cycle is Denver's bike sharing system. With 88 stations and 700 bikes throughout ten central Denver neighborhoods, you can check out and return a B-cycle at any station 5 a.m. to midnight, 365 days a year. Next, discover the 10,000-seat Red Rocks Amphitheatre, a world-renowned site for concerts situated amidst towering cliffs red sandstone rising hundreds of feet above you. Enjoy time in the Visitor Center and Colorado Music Hall of Fame, followed by a delicious lunch at the Ship Rock Grille.

Boulder is a dynamic university community, nestled near the base of the scenic Flatiron Mountains – offering breathtaking views.

Take a quick hike to take pictures and enjoy the wildflowers, or stay for a tour of the historic but active Colorado Chautauqua, a National Historic Landmark. You'll have lunch at the Dushanbe Teahouse in Boulder in which Tajik artisans handcrafted the building in a traditional style that includes ceramic Islamic art and a carved, painted ceiling. Next, you'll visit the famous Pearl Street Mall – an outdoor mall with very unique character that is home to a wide variety of fascinating shops and delicious dining. You'll be given time for shopping on your own before driving through the University of Colorado's expansive campus to see beautiful historical buildings and gorgeous landscaping on the way back to Denver.
