




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FUNDING AND BUDGET *use \$2 federal for every \$1 state*

Federal highway reimbursements are primarily used for capital outlays, including construction, right-of-way acquisition and engineering, but are also used for debt service for GARVEE bonds.



- Potentially on Central 70



I-70 Mountain Express Lane

- Express Lane delivers operational improvements and all lanes benefit
 - Compare speeds from 2012 pre-construction to present/Express Lane (2012 2016):
 - More consistent speeds, clears incidents and we've seen overall faster speeds: 26 to 52% reduced travel times
