US 36 - Project Corridor

- » US 36 Corridor (the "Corridor") is comprised of 23 miles of highway connecting Denver to Boulder, Colorado (dual direction heavy commuter route)
- » The Corridor diagonally bisects the northwest Denver metropolitan area, carrying an average of between 80,000 and 100,000 trips per day
- » The Corridor is economically diverse
 - ~17% of Denver metro region's business (>26,000 businesses) and employment (>200,000 jobs) located along Corridor
- » By 2035, population and employment within 3 miles of the Corridor are anticipated to grow by 28% and 53%, respectively
- » Long-term employment along the Corridor is expected to grow by 129,580 workers with annual wages totaling \$520 billion by 2035
