- > 35 states now use tolling to finance and fund the construction and operation of limited access road infrastructure.
- > Oregon and several other states are trying out road usage charging (RUC), a policy of assessing fees for the use of roadway infrastructure across an entire roadway network (also called VMT or MBUF).
