The Image Review Program AKA Peach Pass

- In 2018, partnership began at Metro Transitional Center (TC)
- In 2021, Partnership expanded to include Metro Reentry Facility (RF)
- Data entry services for image review for our toll facilities
- Provides equity, inclusion, professional development, and employment opportunities
- Opportunity for offenders to obtain OJT credits and transferable skillsets



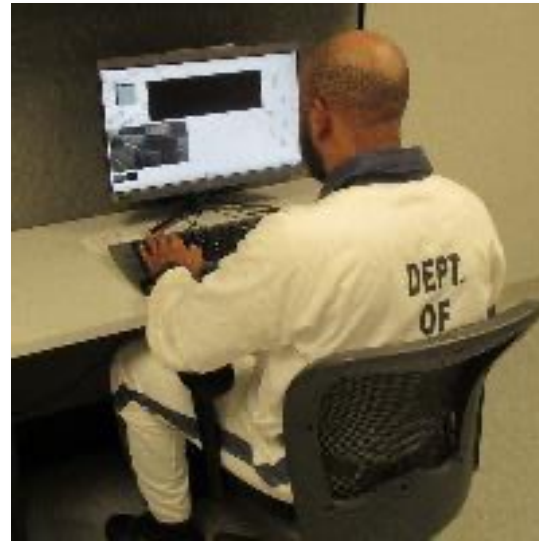
Metro Transitional Center

- 10 female participants.
- Participants typically have 6 to 11 months left on their sentence.
- Located at the Georgia Department of Correction Facility.
- Part-Time SRTA employees. (25 hours per week)
- Teaches data entry skills and prepares them for fulltime employment outside of incarceration.
- Provides verifiable employment history.



Metro Reentry Facility

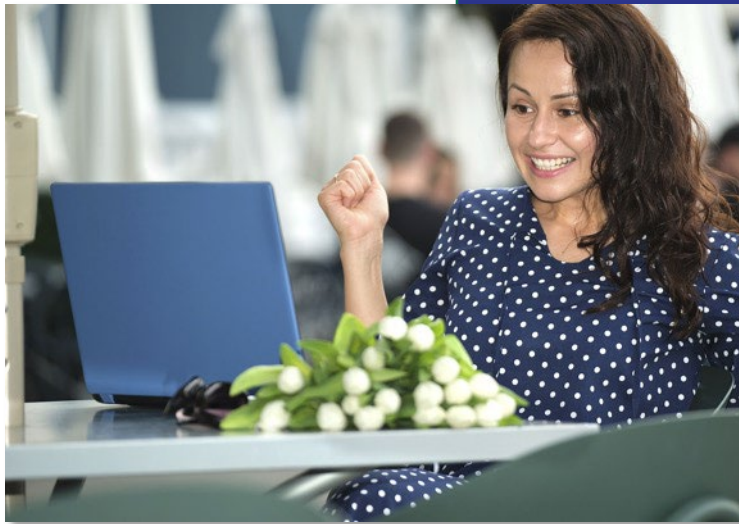
- 12 Male participants
- Participants have a variety of sentences.
- Located at the Georgia Department of Corrections Facility.
- Full-time employees (typically 40 hours)
- Provides educational and OJT credits.
- Provides verifiable employment history.

- Reduces barrier



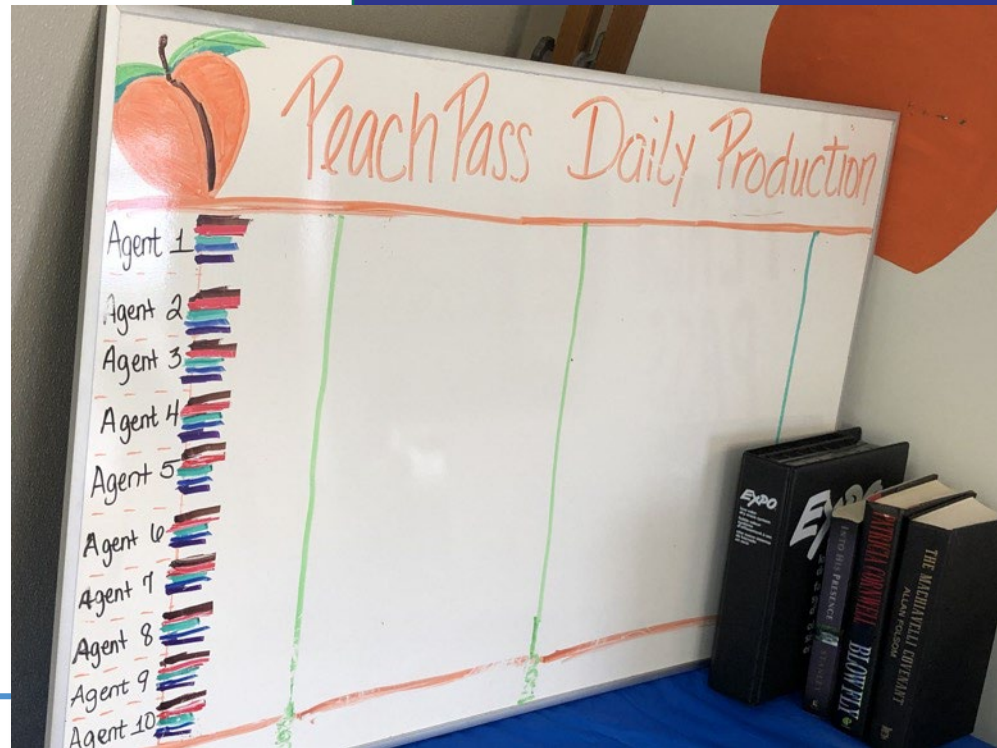
Accomplishments

- Participants have processed over 6,995,915 images with an overall average accuracy rate of 98.4%.
- SRTA has employed over 72 participants
 - 7 accepted full-time employment upon release
- Participants routinely outperform SRTA employees in their proficiency rating

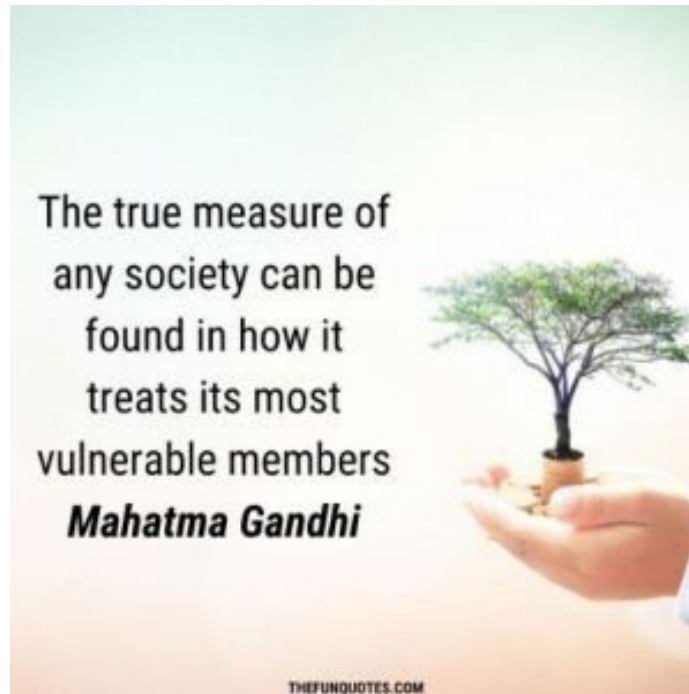


Looking Ahead
