A welcome from the President



Welcome to Cleveland and IBTTA's 2024 Annual Meeting and Exhibition. We're glad you're here!

As most of you know by now, I'm Greek and, therefore, I want to begin my message with a quote from the famous Greek philosopher Aristotle: "We are what we repeatedly do. Excellence, then, is not an act, but a habit."

This year I had the privilege to lead IBTTA under the theme "Advancing Global Tolling Solutions." One of those solutions is to take seriously our commitment to

provide safe passage to those who use our roads, bridges and tunnels. In service of that goal we launched IBTTA's first ever Global Road Safety Campaign built around the theme "Be Safe Together."

The theme "Be Safe Together" recognizes that all of us have a role to play in advancing roadway safety. It makes us recognize that when I'm behind the wheel, every decision I make affects the safety of everyone else on the highway. Because the little things add up.

This year's effort was a communications campaign aimed at encouraging the motoring public to use empathy on the highway. When we are out there in our cars surrounded by two tons of metal, we tend to forget that we share the road with many other human beings. So the message of our campaign is a reminder that we're not alone out there and that if any one of us is hurt on the highway, then all of us suffer, because we are all part of one common humanity.

And this is where Aristotle and habit making come in. We all want to reduce the number of fatalities on our highways to zero. To do that, we need to make safety a habit. We need to commit ourselves to avoid distracted and impaired driving, to drive at a safe speed for the road conditions, and look out for the people in work zones who are striving to make our roads better and safer every day.

During this year's Annual Meeting, we shine a bright light on safety with a full track of safety breakout sessions on Sunday and Monday and a safety general session on Tuesday. We have also devoted a special section of the exhibit hall to safety programs and organizations.

Aristotle was right; we are what we repeatedly do. My deepest hope is that we repeatedly bring empathy and respect to the job of driving. And that we continue to do everything in our power to make our infrastructure and operations as safe as they can possibly be.

Stan Ciszewski

Stan Ciszewski is a 39-year veteran of the New Jersey Turnpike Authority and a longtime member of IBTTA. Serving as the Assistant Director, Data & Performance Management, Ciszewski's dedication to the tolling industry is unmatched. In 1991 IBTTA Past President George Zilocchi appointed Ciszewski to serve as the Electronic Toll and Traffic Management (ETTM) Project Coordinator. Serving on the IBTTA Interoperability Committee from 2014-2018, Ciszewski's leadership across the association and within the industry has been recognized for decades among his peers. Among other responsibilities, Ciszewski represents the Authority on E-ZPass Group's (IAG) Executive Management (EMC), Policy and Technical Committees. He chaired the Policy Committee for six years. He chaired the IAG's Hub Task Force charged with developing an RFP to replace the IAG's peer-to-peer methodology used for communicating E-ZPass information between back-offices with a modern Hub concept. And he serves as one of the Subject Matter Experts on the IAG's day-to-day project management team for the EZIOP Hub and represents the Authority on the task group that manages the project. He holds a Master of Science in Information Systems Engineering from Polytechnic University, Brooklyn, NY and a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from Rutgers University.



Diane Gutierrez-Scaccetti

Diane Gutierrez-Scaccetti's career has spanned over 35 years in the transportation industry and 40 years in government service. A proud New Jersey Native, Diane serves as Senior Advisor to Governor Philip. D. Murphy, having previously served as his Chief of Staff and Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation from 2018 – 2024. From 2011 to 2018, Gutierrez-Scaccetti served as the Executive Director and CEO of Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, a district of the Florida Department of Transportation where she was instrumental in the development of SunTrax, a 2.25-mile test track and research facility focused on advancing transportation technology. Gutierrez-Scaccetti started her transportation career at the New Jersey Turnpike Authority where she spent 21 years, finishing her tenure as Executive Director. Gutierrez-Scaccetti's tenure was marked by significant initiatives, including the remediation of the E-ZPass System the consolidation of the New Jersey Turnpike Authority with the New Jersey Highway Authority, and advancing the largest capital program in Turnpike history. As the 2022 IBTTA President, Guitierrez-Scaccetti theme of Leadership, Resilience and Opportunity, inspired IBTTA members to face the challenges brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic and remain steadfast in building productive and positive change. Her work has been recognized by many other organizations over the years. Among her many achievements, Gutierrez-Scaccetti was appointed Chair of the Transportation Research Board Executive Committee in 2023. She holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Connecticut and a Master of Science degree from Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey.



Barb Jewell

Barb Jewell is the President and Owner of MBI Consulting, Inc., with over 39 years of experience in the tolling industry. She is passionate about her work and has a proven track record in managing complex tolling projects both nationally and internationally. Jewell has led numerous initiatives, from National Interoperability projects to toll collection system implementations. Her recent accomplishments include successfully managing the implementation of National Interoperability between the Central and Southeast Regions, as well as onboarding NET RMA to the North Texas Tollway Authority's (NTTA) back office. She also played a key role in NTTA's back office, contributing to requirements, design, specifications, business rules, testing, and cutover activities. Jewell's impact on the industry dates back to her involvement with early E-ZPass initiatives, the first Team-TX implementation, and pioneering the first National Hub and Hub-to-Hub implementations. She holds a Bachelor of Arts in Applied Mathematics with a Concentration in Computer Science and Statistics from the State University of New York at Buffalo.



David Machamer

David Machamer is a 34-year veteran of the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA), where he served as Assistant Executive Director of PIKEPASS and Toll Operations. A key figure in the introduction of electronic tolling, Machamer played a pivotal role in the success of the PIKEPASS system in 1991 and led its implementation across OTA's turnpike network. An active member of IBTTA for many years, Machamer served on the IBTTA Board from 2002 to 2008 and chaired the IBTTA Toll Excellence Awards Committee from 2008 to 2023. His leadership in this role helped foster innovation and recognize the achievements within the tolling industry. Machamer's dedication to the Toll Excellence Awards is reflected in his 2020 statement: "Toll authorities and industry partners demonstrate their leadership by advancing mobility, safety, and efficiency for drivers worldwide." Under Machamer's leadership, OTA won the Toll Excellence Award for operations in 2012, following the restoration of a customer service center destroyed by fire, and in 2014 for social responsibility, helping communities recover after a devastating tornado. He holds a Master of Business Administration and a bachelor's degree in accounting from the University of Oklahoma.

Winner: 407 ETR's DEI Program

Building Diversity and Inclusivity On and Off the Road: 407 ETR's Commitment to Diversity 407 ETR DEI Program, launched in 2021 and set to complete by December 2024, is a strategic initiative aimed at fostering diversity, equity, and inclusion within the tolling industry. Supported by the Board of Directors and Senior Management, the program focuses on increasing awareness, leadership accountability, and building a diverse and inclusive workforce. Key results include a 12% rise in the inclusion score, a 14% increase in diversity value, and a 7% boost in gender and racial/ethnic representation. With 50% of Executive Officers now identifying as visible minorities, the program also extends its impact through significant investments in youth sponsorships, STEM education, and Indigenous community support. These efforts highlight 407 ETR's commitment to embedding DEI principles into its business strategy and culture.

Private Sector Impact: Dewberry's IDEA Program Fuels Inclusive Futures

Dewberry, a professional services firm specializing in engineering, architecture, and consulting, is committed to delivering innovative solutions and strengthening communities nationwide. Through their IDEA (Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Accessibility) program launched in 2022, Dewberry has cultivated a vibrant and inclusive culture that empowers employees and celebrates diversity. The establishment of six dynamic Employee Resource Groups (ERGs) has created supportive spaces for diverse voices to thrive. Demonstrating a strong commitment to supplier diversity, 75% of their payments now support local businesses, with 98 new firms welcomed into their network through proactive outreach events. In 2023, Dewberry's dedication to making a positive, lasting impact was further evidenced by over 8,600 volunteer hours devoted to community and STEM education initiatives, underscoring their passion for fostering growth and opportunity both within the organization and in the communities they serve.

Winner: Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) Project: I-405 Improvement Project / 405 Express Lanes

Golden State Game-Changer: OCTA's I-405 Express Lanes Transforms Congestion Relief

The I-405 Improvement Project by the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) is a landmark initiative that introduced the 405 Express Lanes along a 16-mile stretch of one of California's busiest freeways. This \$2.2 billion project, the largest highway construction in the state, successfully alleviated congestion by implementing congestion management pricing, which adjusts toll rates hourly based on real-time traffic conditions. This innovation led to a significant reduction in travel times—42% northbound and 35% southbound. OCTA also secured a \$629 million TIFIA loan, saving taxpayers over \$500 million. The project reimagined the corridor by reconstructing 18 bridges, adding bike lanes, and enhancing sidewalks, promoting safer, more sustainable travel. OCTA's effective public outreach minimized disruptions and fostered community support, making the I-405 Improvement Project a deserving recipient of IBTTA's 2024 Toll Excellence Award.

Customer Service & Marketing

Winner: Illinois Tollway Project: I-PASS Assist

Land of Lincoln Leads: Illinois Tollway's I-PASS Assist Drives Equity and Access on the Open Road The Illinois Tollway's I-PASS Assist program is a pioneering, equity-focused initiative designed to support underserved communities by making tollway travel more accessible and affordable. Launched in June 2021, the program has seen a dramatic 15-fold increase in enrollment, growing from 2,500 accounts in 2020 to over 40,000 active accounts. Key innovations include the elimination of the transponder deposit, reducing setup costs, and lowering automatic replenishment fees, which have collectively waived over \$3.7 million in invoice fees. Through targeted outreach and an automated application process, I-PASS Assist has significantly expanded its reach, providing low-income residents with equitable access to transportation, setting a new standard in the tolling industry.

Winner: Colorado Transportation Investment Office Project: CTIO Express Lanes Safety Enforcement Program (SEP)

Mile-High Safety Boost: Colorado's WAL-E Tech Transforms Express Lane Safety

The Colorado Transportation Investment Office (CTI0) implemented an innovative Safety Enforcement Program using Blissway's Wireless Autonomous Lane Enforcer (WAL-E) technology to address illegal weaving and oversized vehicle use on express lanes. Deployed on key corridors like I-70 and I-25, this program led to a 75% decrease in weaving violations and a 20% reduction in serious injury crashes, significantly enhancing traffic safety. Supported by legislative backing and public approval, the program also improved traffic flow, increased toll revenue, and set a new standard for infrastructure-light, sustainable, and cost-effective enforcement in the tolling industry.

Social Responsibility

Winner: Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority Project: Gordie Howe International Bridge

Windsor and Detroit's New Gateway: Gordie Howe Bridge Fuels \$3.17 Billion Growth and Champions Social Change

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project, North America's largest bi-national infrastructure undertaking valued at \$6.4 billion (CDN), exemplifies excellence in social responsibility with measurable achievements. The project has created over 11,400 jobs, with 42% filled by local workers, and engaged 275+ local businesses. It has contributed \$1.87 billion to Detroit's GDP and \$1.3 billion to Windsor's GDP. Environmental efforts include achieving ISO 14001 certification, LEED v4 Silver ratings for its port facilities, and an Envision™ Platinum Award. Socially, the project will invest \$23 million in community improvements, has established a toll-free multi-use path to promote transportation equity, and delivered a Visual Arts Program that includes Indigenous art and a Commemorative piece recognizing the Underground Railroad, all informed by extensive community engagement. These initiatives have earned the project numerous awards, setting a new standard for cross-border infrastructure projects.

Winner: North Carolina Department of Transportation, Turnpike Authority Project: Back Office System 2 Using Cloud Technologies and APIs

NCTA's BOS2 Drives a New Era of Tolling Excellence

The North Carolina Department of Transportation, Turnpike Authority implemented BOS2, a new back-office system in February 2023, revolutionizing NC Quick Pass customer service and toll transaction processing. Replacing a 13-year-old system, BOS2 offers advanced features like cloud-based telephony, an Interactive Voice Response System (IVR), and a mobile app, all built on scalable cloud technologies and APIs. The successful transition involved migrating over 6 million customer accounts, 9 million vehicles, and 1.5 million transponders, along with approximately ten years of account history, toll transactions, and financial activity. Since its deployment, BOS2 has collected over \$280 million in payments and increased NC Quick Pass account adoption by 23%, with over 60% of new accounts converting from Bill-By-Mail to Prepaid NC Quick Pass accounts, setting a new industry standard for tolling technology.



Toll Operations, Engineering and Maintenance

Winner: Tampa Hillsborough Expressway Authority (THEA) Project: East Selmon Slip Ramps

Navigating the Sunshine City: THEA's East Selmon Slip Ramps Ease Tampa's Traffic Tide

The East Selmon Slip Ramps project, initiated by the Tampa Hillsborough Expressway Authority (THEA), effectively addressed growing congestion and changing travel behaviors on the Selmon Expressway, a critical east-west toll road in Tampa, Florida. In response to a 100% surge in traffic over the past decade and projected future increases, THEA introduced two new slip ramps, allowing westbound drivers to access and exit the All-Electronic Reversible Express Lanes (REL) more efficiently, bypassing the congested downtown core. This innovation has significantly reduced morning congestion, particularly at critical intersections and near an elementary school, enhancing safety and improving the overall commuter experience. The project's strategic design not only optimizes traffic flow but also defers substantial future expenditures, showcasing THEA's commitment to cost-effective, innovative infrastructure solutions.

Private Sector Innovation

Winner: Indra USA, Inc. Project: 66 Express Outside the Beltway

Innovating Virginia's Highways: Indra Leads Private Sector Breakthrough on I-66

Indra's implementation of all-overhead tolling and traffic technology at the Transform 66 Outside the Beltway project, a major transportation corridor in Northern Virginia, has significantly advanced the tolling industry, exemplifying innovation and excellence. Managed by I-66 Express Mobility Partners LLC, this first-of-its-kind tolling solution utilizes LiDAR for dimensions-based classification and Video AI for axle-based classification, all integrated into an advanced smart-road system. Going live ahead of schedule in November 2022, it has drastically improved traffic flow along this critical commuter route, reducing travel times by 54% in the express lanes. The project sets a new standard for tolling systems globally, with its innovative use of commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) technology and holistic approach, including video-based occupancy detection, providing a blueprint for future implementations.



Leader & Chief Engineer, NASA Mars 2020 Mission, Rover Perseverance

Described as a cross between "Einstein and Elvis Costello," Adam Steltzner is a leader heralded for making the impossible possible. And he wants to know "How great do YOU dare to become?"

An aspiring rock star turned Ph.D. rocket scientist, Adam Steltzner is praised as a cutting-edge innovator and a leader who literally brings out the very best in his teams. Adam serves as Chief Engineer of the current Mars 2020 Mission & Rover Perseverance that has the ultimate objective of determining if life existed on Mars.

A mission ten years in the making, Mars 2020 was plunged into uncertainty at a crucial juncture by the global pandemic. Preparing a mission for Mars and not making any mistakes is immensely difficult under the best conditions. Suddenly, Steltzner and the Jet Propulsion Laboratory team of 6,000+ was forced to operate remotely. The collaborative teams pressed on and remarkably maintained all of the original assembly and launch timetables. After a 6-month journey through space, history was made on February 18th when the Rover Perseverance spectacularly landed on the Martian surface, more than 200,000,000 miles from Earth.

Adam earlier led a breakthrough team that created the ingenious "sky crane" landing system for the Rover Curiosity that landed on Mars in 2012. The achievement prompted leadership guru Simon Sinek to state, "[Steltzner] shows us that doing what others think is impossible takes more than grit and courage. It takes the ability to inspire people . . . It takes leadership." Steltzner was also honored with the "American Ingenuity" Award from the Smithsonian Institution.

Adam is the author of *The Right Kind of Crazy: A True Story of Teamwork, Leadership and High Stakes Innovation,* that was named a "best leadership book of the year" by the Washington Post. CEO READ picked the book as "Editor's Choice" for its unique strategies and perspectives.

Steltzner brings a rock-star's presence and a storyteller's gift to the stage with his keynote speeches. Adam has mastered the art of managing complex teams and the concept of "making ideas reality." He knows first-hand how collaborative cultures foster innovation and how team-minded engagement fuels performance. And he inspires audiences to dare greatly – to embrace the power of curiosity, creativity, and courage to do what others say is impossible.


