- 3. Review reports to analyze projections of revenue against actual figures and budgeted expenses against final totals. Suggest methods of improving the planning process as appropriate.
- 4. Analyze company operations to pinpoint opportunities and areas that need to be reorganized, down-sized, or eliminated.
- 5. Confer with Executive Director and executive staff to coordinate and prioritize planning.
- 6. Study long-range economic trends and projects company prospects for future growth in overall sales and market share, opportunities for acquisitions or expansion into new product areas. Estimate requirements for capital, land, buildings, and an increase in the work force.
- 7. Supervise investment of funds; work with banks and/or investment bankers to raise additional capital as required for expansion.
